# STEWARDSHIP Questions & Answers

#### WHAT IS STEWARDSHIP?

Stewardship is how we keep the Church's mission alive and functioning! It is a simple, equitable and Christian way by which each parishioner (family or individual) determines the amount they will commit for the support of the Church, proportionate to his or her income.

#### WHY HAVE A STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM?

Such a program eliminates inequities and places the responsibility of Kimisis in the hands of each parishioner. It helps us take financial responsibility for our church accordning to our financial means.

#### HOW DO I BECOME STEWARD?

By filling out the enclosed pledge form and mailing and/or bringing it to the Church. Our Payment program can also be accessed on our website

#### WHO IS INCLUDED IN MY FAMILY COMMITMENT?

A pledging family includes husband, wife, and children under the age of 18.

#### WHAT ABOUT SINGLE WORKING ADULTS?

Every working, self-supporting adult over 18 years old must make his/her own commitment. This is a necessary for an adult Orthodox Christian to become a member in good standing in a parish of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese (Part 3, article 18 Uniform Parish Regulations)

#### WHO DETERMINES THE LEVEL OF OFFERING?

We encourage everyone to take a look at the chart below. It compares levels of giving to annual gross income. Where does our giving fit in—not in proportion to charts, and solicited donations, but also to the biblical standard of tithing 10% of our assets to God?

#### HOW MUCH DO I OWE?

Like many parishes, Kimisis once relied on "sugg ested minimum donations" (i.e. "dues"). "Minim um donations" will not help our pay expenses that can exceed \$28,000/mo. We must set aside an hon est and fair portion of our income for the ministries and operations of Kimisis to take place.

#### When should I send my pledge?

Stewardship occurs on a calendar year basis. Parishioners are asked to fulfill their pledges by December 31 of the year in which they are pledging. Payments can be made on a monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual basis.

#### WILL MY PLEDGE BE CONFIDENTIAL?

The names of all pledged stewards will be published in our church publications. However, all pledge amounts are kept in the strictest confidence.

#### CAN I REVISE MY COMMITMENT?

You can change your pledge according to your changing financial situation by advising the parish priest or a member of the parish council. Again, this is always kept in strict confidence.

## SUGGESTED LEVELS OF OFFERING

Whether you are a long-standing member or new to our community, Kimisis will always need your support. Your Christian Stewardship commitment and support provides our parish and the Church at large with the necessary resources.

After you have read this information and discussed it with your family, please complete the pledge form and return it to the Church office. Thank you for your support.

The table below consists of suggested amounts per annual household income. Think about it – the average financial pledge through the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America is 218.00/yr. Considering the needs of the Church, and the standard of tithing 10% of our time, talent, and treasure.
